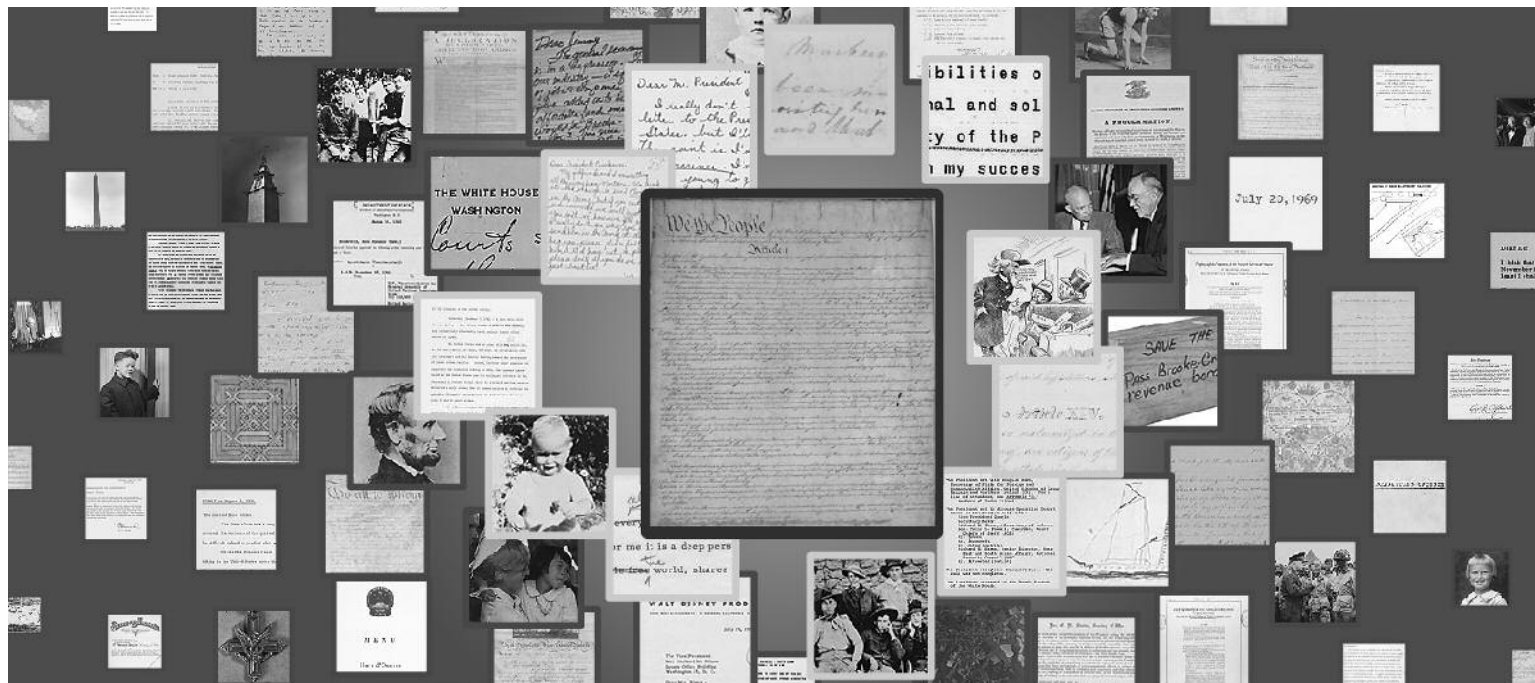


The National Archives Holds 10 Billion Records.
